# Insurance and **Passengers**

CAMS Personal Accident Insurance and Passengers

CAMS has been in discussion with OAMPS about providing Personal Accident Însurance (PAI) for Passengers in vehicles in non-competitive activities. CAMS is pleased to announce passengers, undertaking permitted non competitive activities such as Passenger Rides, Come and Try and Sponsor/Media Days are now covered by CAMS PAI. All passengers will continue to be required to complete a CAMS "Passenger in Vehicles" waiver.

CAMS can also confirm that when a licensed competitor is acting as an instructor or coach (i.e. being a passenger) during permitted non competitive activities, such as Driver Training activities or Come and Try Days, then they are covered by CAMS PAI.

CAMS will modify the post event paperwork to record the number of passenger's in vehicles during permitted non-competitive activities.

This is an exciting development and we hope it will encourage more people to get involved in the sport.



# Club Permit Information



PROCESS FOR OBTAINING CLUB PERMITS FOR VEHICLES.

The following is the current process for getting your vehicle onto the Club Permit

First of all the vehicle must be a minimum of 25 years old (to the month) and in roadworthy condition. Current registration is not necessary. The owner MUST present a current Club membership card and MUST remain a member in order to continue to use the vehicle.

When ready contact the Clubs designated officer to arrange processing.(Details below.)

The vehicle is to be checked for suitability for use on Club Plates either with a roadworthy certificate or by myself as the designated officer. A nominal fee is charged for the check.

Once the paperwork is completed you go to Vic Roads for processing.

You have a choice of either 45 or 90 day permits, and it's a log book system which you are responsible for.

After you receive your plates and paperwork from Vic Roads (usually up to 3 weeks,) it is YOUR responsibility to notify me with the expiry date and plate details. The Club is responsible for keeping accurate records. At present that's me. Therefore, if you sell the vehicle, smash it, remove it from the road, don't renew you membership, or change Clubs, you MUST notify me and in some cases hand back the plates to Vic Roads.

RENEWING YOUR CLUB PERMIT.

When your permit is nearing its expiry date you will automatically receive a renewal from Vic Roads which you then must get signed by me. At present the Club is asking a fee of \$5 for all renewals to help cover the cost of being a member of A.O.M.C. Payable on me signing off your permit.

PLEASE REMEMBER THAT YOU ARE RESPONSIBLE TO MAINTAIN YOUR VEHICLE IN A ROADWOR-THY STATE. SOME VEHICLES THAT HAVEN'T BEEN SEEN OUT AT THE CLUB FOR A WHILE MAY REQUIRE A CHECK TO BE CARRIED OUT PRIOR TO RENEWAL.



# History Slice

#### **BLCC Bulletin April 1998**

Friday 20th March 1998 - a day to remember for 14 students from the Ballarat Specialist School. Students and staff were given a chance to go for a ride around the Ballarat Light Car Club autocross Track in Philip Masseur's Silverstone Lancer GSR. The day was made possible by Philip Messer and Alun Owen & Graham Osborne from Silverstone Victoria.


