Josh raced his new Australian Pulsar Racing Association N14 Pulsar to 3rd place in the juniors improving his times by 7 seconds from round 1. Josh's best time was 1.49.25 with his standing lap 1.53.03

Richard also had his first drive of Josh's Pulsar liking the SR20 power & the controlled suspension package with a best time of 1.45.10 and standing lap 1.47.220. Out of the 80 cars competing Richard had the closest standing & flying lap times, being 2.1 seconds difference.
