First time vehicles being submitted must be owned by the applicant and be accompanied by a **current Victorian Roadworthy Certificate** obtained by the owner.

OR

First time vehicles being submitted THAT ARE BUILT PRIOR TO 1949 must be owned by the applicant and a **current Victorian Roadworthy Certificate** IS NOT REQUIRED.

Applications must also include a series of 7 photographs as below:

**7 Photographs** (hard copy 6x4 colour prints). These will be stamped with the date received by the Permit Officer onto each print. Quality of prints must be acceptable to Permit Officer.

- \*Front view. \* Driving Position (Side driver's door open).
- \*Rear view. \* Engine bay (bonnet open).
- \* Engine number.

Original Vic Roads Club Permit application form completed where required by the applicant.

Photocopy of the completed Vic Roads Permit application form.

Original of Vic Roads Vehicle Eligibility and Standards Declaration for Club Permit Vehicles.

Photocopy of Vic Roads Vehicle Eligibility and Standards Declaration for Club Permit Vehicles.

Applicants are required to supply **ORIGINALS AND COPIES** of the documentation as listed below when applying for Club Permit Scheme (CPS) approval.

All applications deemed to be "M" plate vehicles must be referred to the B.L.C.C.
Committee by the Permit Officer for approval in line with B.L.C.C. rule 5 of the CPS policy.

Members must attend at least **one** B.L.C.C. calendared event per year with the vehicle, and have the vehicles logbook signed by a Committee member or representative.

- This could be a Clerk of Course of an event or one of the organising members of the event attended.
- Please also note that any of the Committee members can ask to see a club plated vehicle's logbook at any time, to ensure that the logbook is being used correctly.
- Any modifications that are (or singular modification) made to the vehicle after it has been accepted into the scheme will also need to be cleared with the Committee, to ensure the Club remains comfortable with how the car or bike is presented. (As per VSI 8 and VSI 33).
- Club "Rego" is not an avenue to bypass engineering approval for a vehicle and getting it on the road. VASS certification will be necessary for those vehicles that do not comply with Vic Road's VSI 8.

\*Please note that the Club Plate Permit Scheme and inspection takes time, and won't be rushed just because you have say 2 days left on your regular registration. PLAN AHEAD.
