With the VRC & VCRS now at their halfway point for 2022, I thought it would be a good time to take a look at those BLCC members who have put in the hard work, and some hard cash, to get their cars and themselves up to scratch and fit enough to compete in these championships and representing the Ballarat Light Car Club.

Ross Stapleton Nissan 200SX Series VRC

Mitta Mountain Rally saw an uncharacteristic DNF on SS2 for Ross and regular navigator Peter Ellis (HRA) with the event starting in close to perfect weather conditions it quickly changed to torrential rain making the roads hazardous with 16 crews not completing the rally.

Ada River Rally had BLCC member Simon Ellis sitting in the navigator's seat for Ross whilst Peter was away on other duties, the event went well and the results for the crew were 16th O/R and 4th in CL

Marysville Stages with the return of regular navigator Peter and having a pretty good run in the event Ross came away with a result of 14th O/R and 3rd in CL.

Paul Mahony BMW 318i E30 Series VCRS

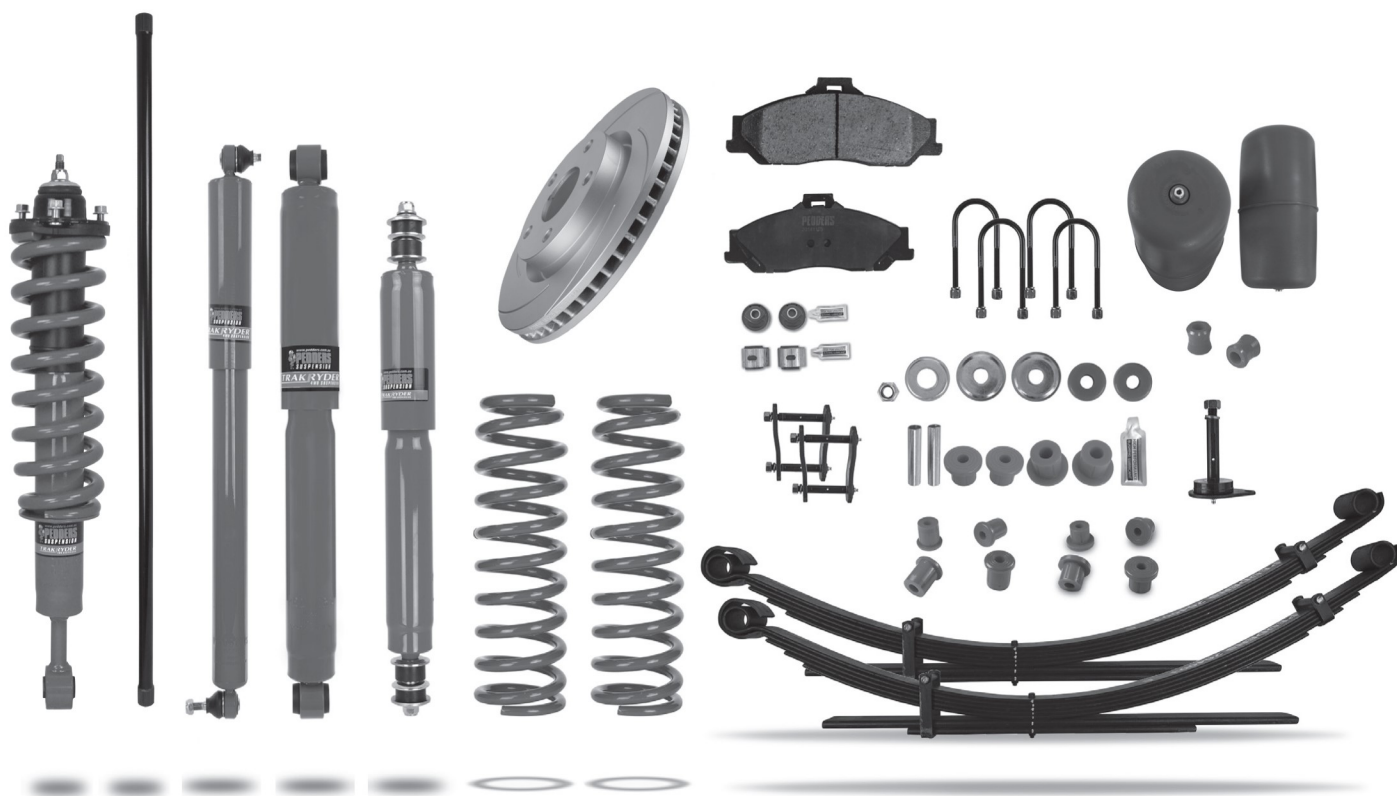
